- 1 Model spiders have 8 legs. How many spiders can be made from 278 legs?

- 2 I have 125 photograph frames. How many boxes do I need to carry all the frames, if each box can carry 8 frames?

- 3 A train ticket costs £53. How many tickets can I buy if I have £244?

- 4 354 apples need to be packed in boxes. 40 apples fit in a box. How many full boxes of apples will there be?

- 5 A machine sews buttons onto coats. Each coat has 7 buttons. The machine breaks after sewing 328 buttons. How many coats are finished?

- 6 152 children and teachers will travel on a trip to the theatre in coaches. Each coach has 59 seats. How many coaches are needed?

- 7 I have 5m of ribbon. I want to tie an 850 mm length of ribbon to each balloon. How many balloons can be tied with ribbon?
