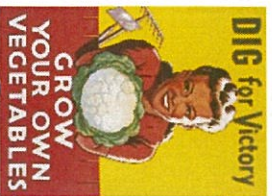


P6/7 Newsletter: Our Learning this Year

Our topics this year have been World War 2, Japan and Fair Trade. We learnt about Christianity, Buddhism and Hinduism. We discussed how to manage change, and how to keep ourselves safe from substance misuse. We learnt about different types of rocks, mixing and dissolving materials, categorising living things, plants in society and fertilisers. We designed and carried out some "fair test" experiments.

We discussed safety around electricity, safety around water, first aid and food safety. We made sushi as part of our Japan topic, and some delicious tray bakes for the school's Jubilee celebrations.
