Our Aim

At Auchinairn Nursery we offer an open door policy and Open Access where parents/carers are welcome to discuss any issues or concerns. Although parents are not required to assist during our normal sessions, we encourage any parent who feels that they have a particular skill or interest to come and share this with the nursery as a whole.

Working in Partnership with You

In addition to the daily contact with parents/carers, there is also a notice board, a white board with daily news, a monthly newsletter, website, pre-school/primary profiles, Curriculum Evening and twice yearly parent/carer evenings.

We hold and Induction Afternoon in June for our new intake of children in August. For all children beginning nursery an on line Learning Journal is started. This information is shared with parents/carers throughout their child's time at nursery and will be forwarded to the relevant primary when they move on to school. This profile can be viewed at any time through the Learning Journal website and parents are encouraged to participate in these journals.
