Teeth Brushing Policy

By introducing a tooth brushing programme, it is the aim of Auchinairn Nursery to promote and improve each child's oral health. Dental disease can cause severe pain and affect eating, speaking and the positioning of permanent teeth.

Parents will be asked to sign consent forms allowing their child to participate in the programme which will be part of the daily nursery routine.

This will encourage the children to brush their teeth at home and raise awareness of the importance of good oral hygiene throughout wider family and community.

The nursery policy of providing healthy snacks along with this tooth brushing programme will help reduce the incidence of dental disease in young children.
