

PROPORTION

STEPS

- Record appropriate headings with the value you have to find on the **RIGHT**
- Find the value of **ONE ITEM FIRST**
- **MULTIPLY** by the required number

WORKED EXAMPLE

If 5 bananas cost 80p, how much do 3 bananas cost?

	Bananas	Cost (pence)
Divide by 5 to find the cost of one banana	5	80
→	1	$80 \div 5 = 16$
	3	$16 \times 3 = 48p$
	3 bananas cost 48p	

ROUNDING

ALWAYS ROUND UP FOR 5 AND ABOVE.

WORKED EXAMPLES

2145 (to the nearest 10)	=	2150
2145 (to the nearest 100)	=	2100
2145 (to the nearest 1000)	=	2000
347.5 (to the nearest whole number)	=	347.5
347.5 (to the nearest 10)	=	350
347.5 (to the nearest 100)	=	300
7.51 (to one decimal place (d.p.))	=	7.5
8.96 (to 1 d.p.)	=	9.0
3.14159 (to 3 d.p.)	=	3.142
3.14159 (to 2 d.p.)	=	3.14
3.14159 (to 3 significant figures (sig. figs.))	=	3.14
