- **Problem Solving**
- **Please take leaflet that will keep you updated as to what mental maths will be covered throughout the year. Term 1 will focus on 4 processes, whole number, estimating and rounding, negative numbers and multiples, factors and prime numbers.**

# Literacy

- **3 organisers:**

- Reading – personal reading. Some children will be given books. We will also be reading a number of class novels starting with Divided City.
- Writing – Talk 4 Writing includes spelling and grammar
- Listening and talking

- **Format of lesson:** Warm up – Activity (written tasks) - Plenary

- **Task boards/activities/resources**
