

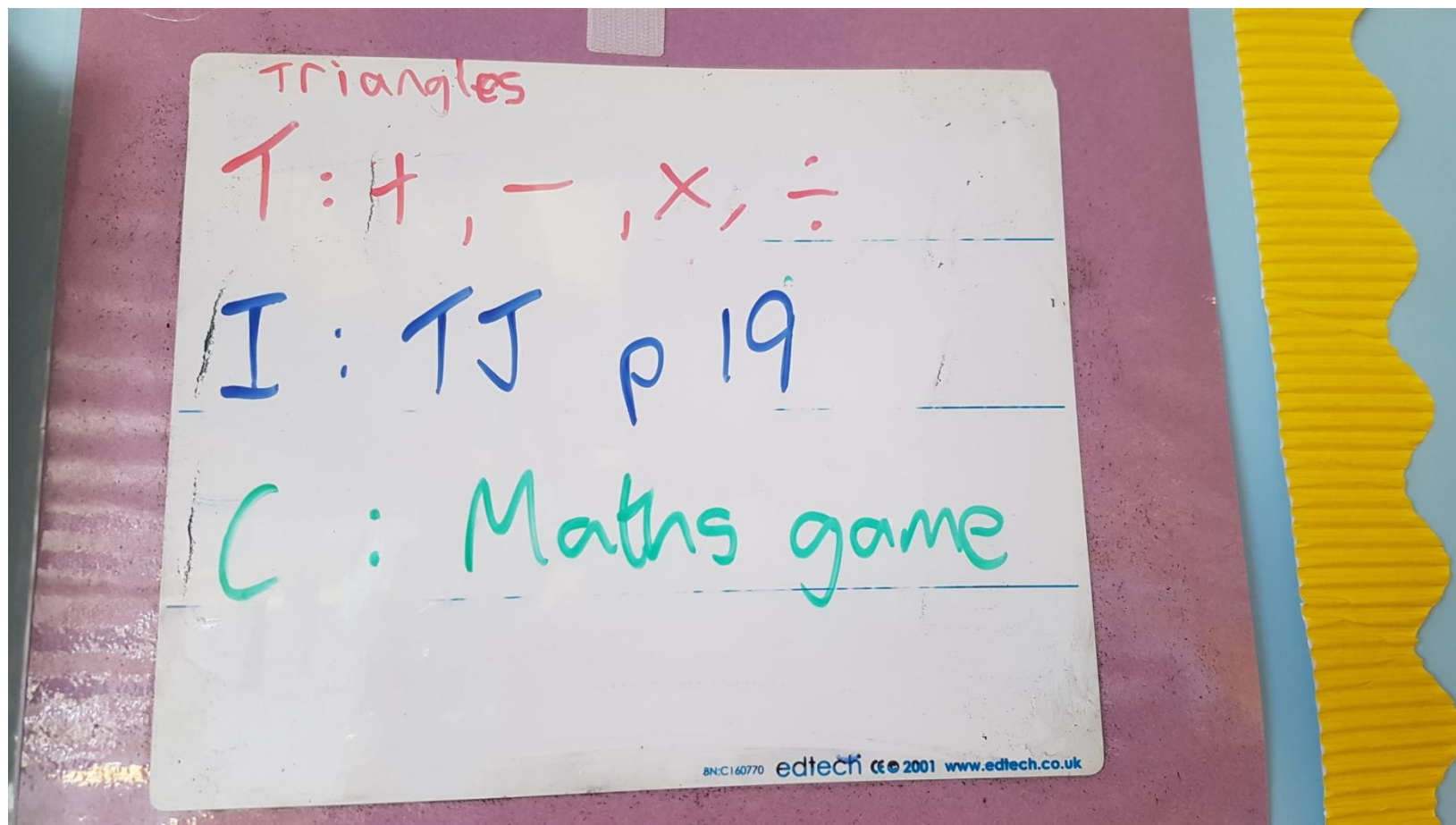

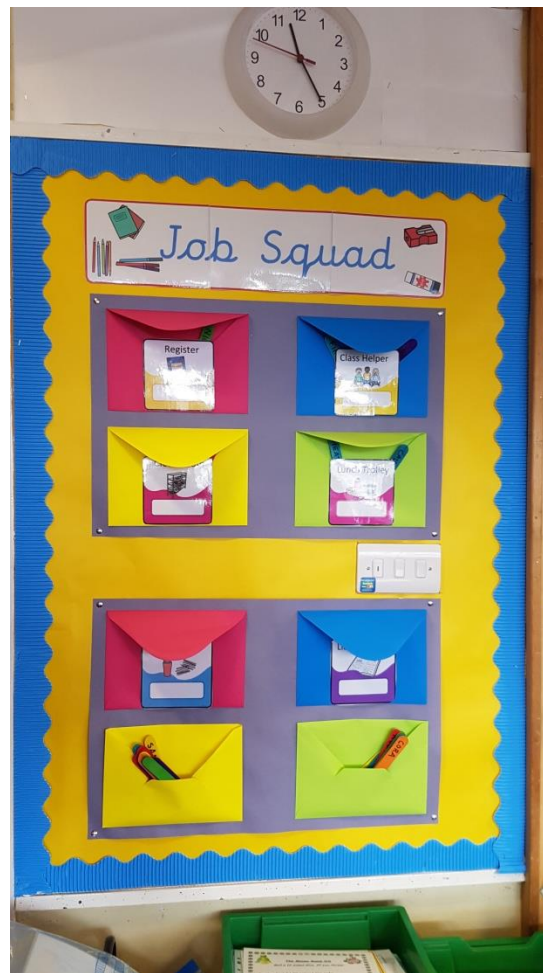
Spelling: Please see the spelling booklet for exact instructions.

Numeracy and Mathematics: Children will receive questions based on their learning in class; this will be glued into their homework jotter and should be completed and handed in on a Friday morning. Children are also encouraged to use 'Sumdog' to consolidate their numeracy and mathematics skills.

Reading: The children will be given allocated pages of their school reading book to read at home. The homework diary should then be signed to confirm reading homework has been completed. Once again, children are being encouraged to use '**Bug Club**' to extend their reading.

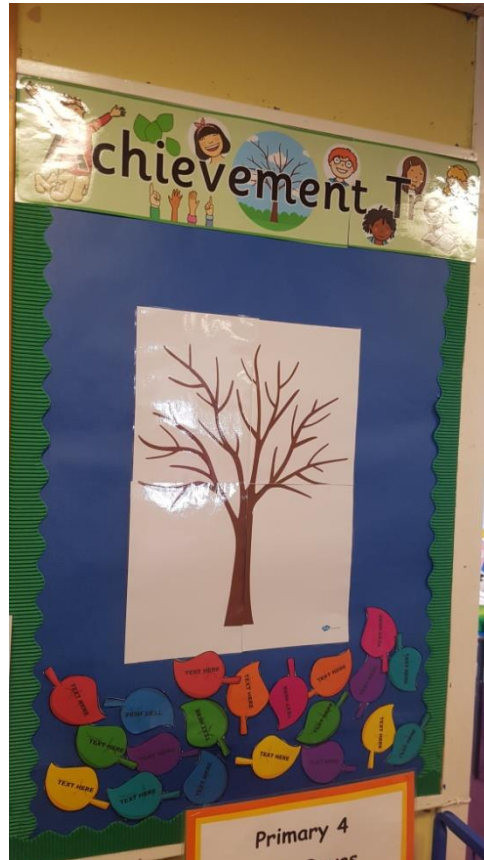
Our rights
