

Numeracy & Maths

Term 1:

- Adding and subtracting numbers within 100.
- Counting on and back in 1's, 2's, 5's and 10's.
- Verbalising 3 digit numbers e.g. 327 = three hundred and twenty-seven.
- Place value e.g. 327 represents 3 hundreds, 2 tens and seven ones.
- Money using different combinations of coins to pay for things and giving change.

Literacy

Areas taught every week:

- Reading comprehension
- Reading groups
- Taught writing
- Spelling/Grammar
- Handwriting

Children will also write their weekend news on Monday mornings.

- Term 1: Local environment study, Glasgow




Growth Mindset
