Playtime

Morning break is between 10.30am and 10.45am and children can bring in a healthy snack to have during this time. Baljaffray Primary School is a nut free school so can you please ensure that all snacks do not contain any nuts. Children should be reminded that they should not share snacks with anyone due to food allergies.

Belongings

All items your child wears or brings to school should be **clearly labelled** with their name and class. This helps to return items to their owners quickly and avoids confusion.

Water Bottles

Children can bring water bottles into school and there is an area in the classroom where children can place their water bottles, accessing them when required. Can you please ensure your child's water bottle is also clearly labelled?

PE

This term PE lessons will take place on a **Wednesday** afternoon and a **Friday** morning. Gym kit should be kept in a bag in school and should consist of black shorts, a white t-shirt and soft shoes. On gym days your child may wear a white polo shirt to school to help with changing. All items of kit, including the bag, should be clearly labelled with your child's name and class. We would also like to remind you that no jewellery should be worn on PE days.

Outdoor Learning

Every **Tuesday** afternoon pupils will engage in outdoor learning, exploring a range of activities. Please ensure your child has boots or wellies and a waterproof jacket with a hood every Tuesday.

To help your child at home please encourage them to discuss with you what they have learned at school each day and what they have enjoyed. If you have any questions please feel free to contact us via the school office where an appointment can be arranged.
