Numeracy and Mathematics Our main focus this term will be subtraction. The children will be encouraged to record the sum using this format.

We will also be developing our awareness of how money is used. The children will be able to identify coins, learn to pay for items and give the correct change.



Data Handling

We will be learning to collect data and ask questions to gather information. The children will learn to organise and display their findings in graphs and charts.





Primary Three will continue to develop their knowledge of grammar by learning about nouns, adjectives, verbs and adverbs. We will also be finding out how to use speech marks in our writing to show that someone is talking. We will continue to read a variety of fiction and non-fiction texts.



Trip to Vikingar As part of our social studies topic we will be learning about Vikings. On Thursday 12th of March we will be going to visit Vikingar in Largs. We will complete the outing with a trip to Nardini's cafe for an ice-cream! We also hope to build our own boats and will aim to take them to some running water to see if they will float. We will complete some outdoor learning to see if we can learn about trees, animals and the environment Vikings lived in.



We will be learning about materials. The children will be able to correctly use the terms soluble (dissolve) and insoluble (insoluble) to describe how substances react in water.
