P6 Termly Update

January - April 2020

Topic - Victorians

This term, pupils in Primary 6 will be learning about life in Victorian times. We will be studying the industrial revolution, looking at the rise and fall of the British Empire, learning about the educational and social reforms, investigating the inventions / discoveries of the time and evaluating how all of this has impacted on life today.

We will be visiting the Scotland Street Museum to learn what life was like in a victorian school and experience a lesson for ourselves.

We will also be visiting New Lanark to develop an understanding of factory life in the midst of the industrial revolution.

We will study some of the most famous artwork of the time and use it as inspiration for our own pieces as well as learning about the medical advancements of the era with a focus on biology.

Mathematics

In mathematics this term we will focus on the subjects of Time (including speed distance, time), Angles (naming, measuring and finding missing angles) and Algebra involving substitution and equations. In addition to this we will continue to develop our arithmetic and problem solving skills
